## FALL & WINTER BLOOMERS

**Faithful Daily Watering** is essential because all of these flowers have very shallow root systems which dry quickly.

Planting them requires no more than a hand trowel to dig 6 inches deep. If you avoid using mulch, many of these will re-seed themselves and show up next year.
